The charming, old-time allure of Brooks Shaw's Old Country Store combined with southern soul cooking and desserts makes it an iconic piece of Jackson that you don't want to miss. The Old Country Store is a hit among locals and tourists alike and is recognized as a top tourist attraction in Tennessee. The buffet features southern favorites like catfish, fried chicken, black-eyed peas, sweet potatoes, and barbecue. Daily specials include hot tamale pie, creamed spinach and baked cinnamon apples. After digging into the southern buffet and abundant salad bar, visit the ice cream parlor located inside the Old Country Store. Miss Anne's Ice Cream Shoppe feels like a time capsule from the 1890s. Indulge in a scoop or two of classic Blue Bell ice cream and admire the shop's nostalgic feel. Be sure to snap a photo of the antique soda fountain, which is over 130 years old and is only one of three of its kind known to exist today.

Century Farm Winery was founded by Jo and Carl O’Cain. Carl’s love for winemaking began as a personal hobby that started to grow as friends, family, and wine-lovers tasted his wine. This resulted in Century Farm, an award-winning winery that sits on Jo’s family land. The property features scenic farmland and an inviting vineyard and tasting room.

Choose from a selection of classic dry reds, semi-sweet reds, white and blush wines, sweet and fruit wines, or dessert wines. Seasonal options include warm mulled wine in the colder months or cold slushes in the summertime. Century Farm encourages visitors to stop by their tasting room for a free tasting featuring 3 different wines. Private tastings are also offered for visitors to learn more about the farm’s history and production process, with a guided tasting of 8 different wines.

From May through October, Century Farm welcomes guests to the winery for their free concert series, “Voices in the Vineyard.” Guests are invited to reserve a table or bring a lawn chair, order eats from local food trucks, and enjoy the free tunes. One of the country's largest Native American Middle Woodland Period mound group can be found at Pinson Mounds, a national historic landmark located in southern Madison County. Covering more than 1,200 acres, the park contains at least 15 Native American mounds, the most famous of which is the large Saul's Mound in the center of the park. Archaeologists believe that the mounds served both burial and ceremonial purposes.

Today, visitors can enjoy six miles of hiking trails with access to the Native American mounds and picnic facilities which include tables and grills. The Pinson Mounds Museum, which was built to resemble a Native American mound, includes 4,500 square feet of exhibit space, an archaeological library, and an 80-seat theater.

The park hosts events throughout the year including guided hikes, educational events, and the annual ArchaeoFest, a celebration of Native American culture and archeology. For more information about upcoming events, visit the park's Facebook page.

SAUL'S MOUND

Saul's Mound is the largest of the Pinson Mounds and the second-highest surviving Native American mound in the United States.

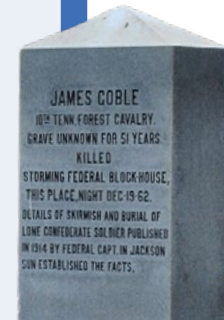
On April 6-7, 1862, one of the largest engagements in the Civil War Mississippi Valley Campaign took place around Shiloh Church and Pittsburg Landing. The battle resulted in the greatest number of casualties of any war fought on American soil at that time. Confederate soldiers surprised Union Major General Ulysses S. Grant and his men near Shiloh Church on April 6th. The battle raged on for two days, resulting in a Union victory and the death of Confederate commander Albert Sidney Johnston.

Today, guests can visit Shiloh National Military Park to learn more about the battle that transpired there. Exhibits help visitors visualize the historical events with displays and films. Outdoor activities include biking and hiking trails. Headstones mark the resting place of 3,892 soldiers and sailors at The Shiloh National Cemetery. Visitors may also pick up a map at the visitor center and set out on a 12.7 mile self-guided auto driving tour of the battlefield that includes 20 stops along the way. For more information and a calendar of events, visit the National Park Service website.

Salem Cemetery Battlefield

On December 19, 1862, the Confederate Brigadier General Nathan Bedford Forrest was on a two-month raid of West Tennessee, seeking to destroy railroad tracks and disrupt Union supply lines. Upon reaching Jackson, the Confederate brigade encountered the Union garrison led by Adolph Engelmann. Confederates charged into the Old Salem Cemetery, where Union soldiers took defense. While the battle transpired, Bedford and other Confederate soldiers withdrew to destroy sections of the railroad to the North before retreating into other parts of West Tennessee. The Battle at Parker's Crossroads would take place 12 days later (see pg. 50). 120 acres of Salem Cemetery and Battlefield have been preserved and are open for visitors to view.



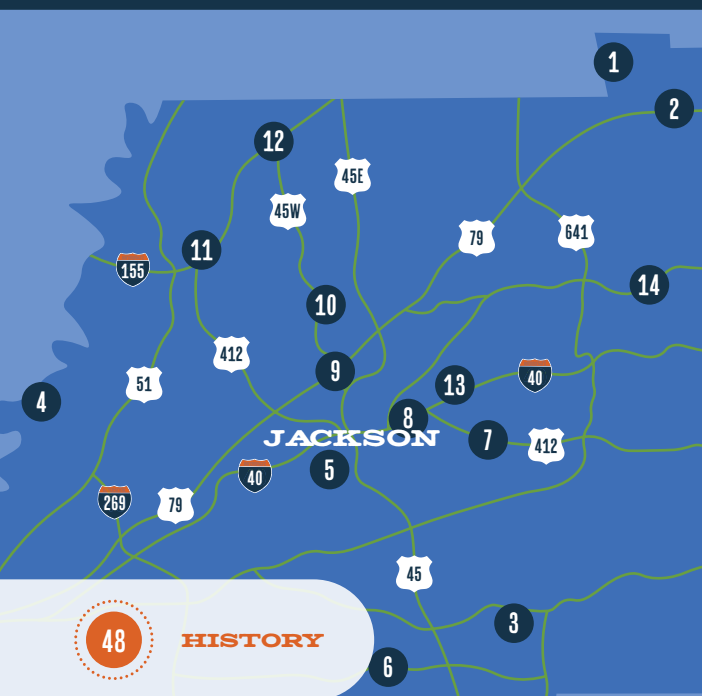

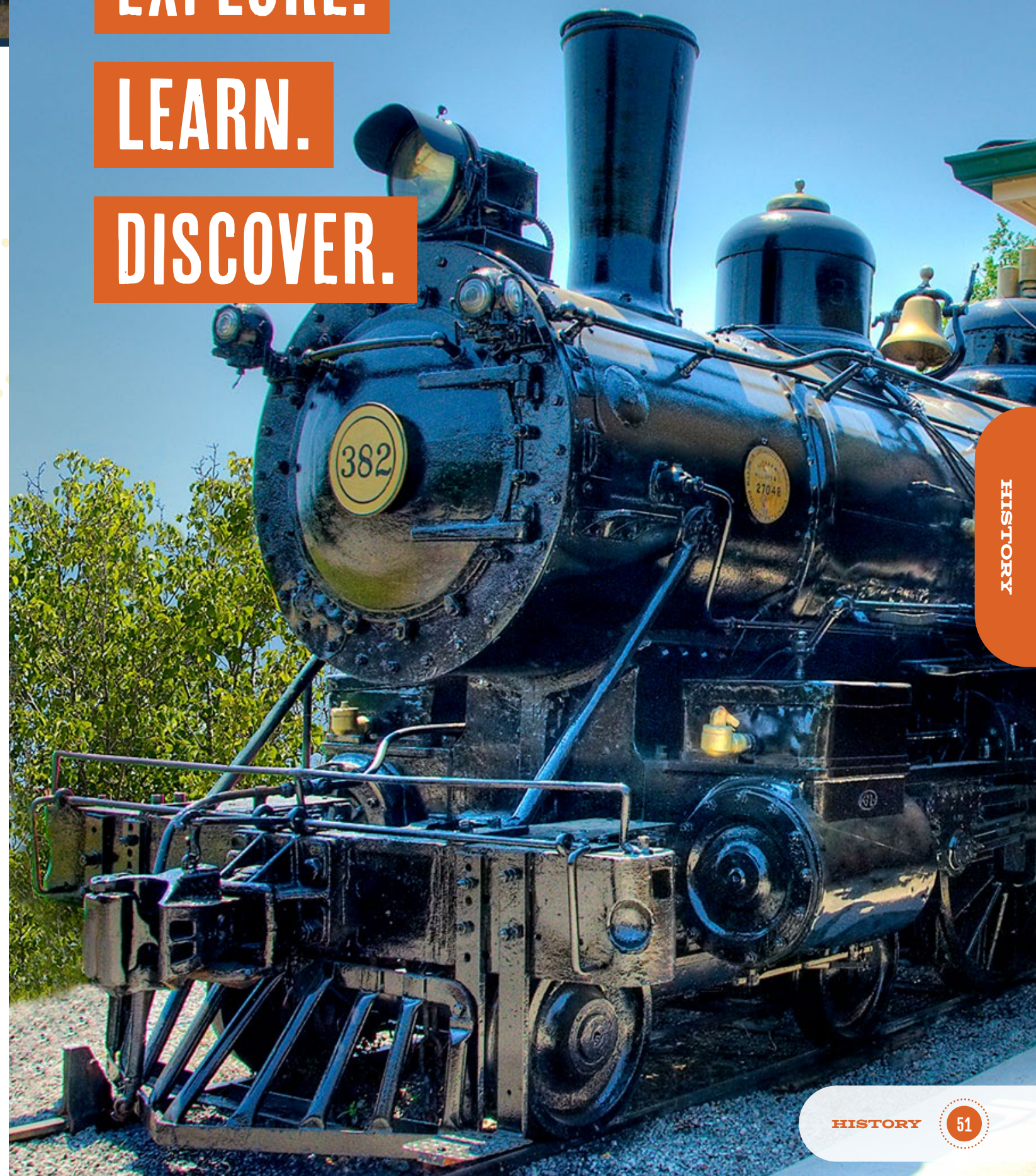

On December 31, 1862, the Battle at Parker's Crossroads took place. Confederate soldiers, commanded by General Nathan Bedford Forrest, were engaged by two Union brigades, commanded by General Jeremiah C. Sullivan, seeking to cut them off from crossing the Tennessee River. The skirmish heightened when one of the Union brigades surprised the Confederate soldiers with an attack from behind. The Confederates were able to escape and withdraw across the Tennessee River.

The core battlefield at Parker's Crossroads has been preserved and can be explored by visitors. Guests can stop at the Visitor Center to grab a map for a self-guided tour. A walking trail winds through the battlefield and passes by cannon replicas as well as signs with more details on the area's history and stories of those who fought at Parker's Crossroads.

TRAILS AND BYWAYS

Woven through Tennessee are many trails and byways that visitors can follow to connect with the history of our amazing state. Three of those trails can be found right here in West Tennessee. Following the trail maps connects visitors with the culture of the past and present throughout West Tennessee and encourages them to venture off the beaten path to discover an abundance of hidden gems throughout the region.

Cotton Junction Trail, named after the signature cotton fields of the region, takes travelers on a rural journey through West Tennessee with 105 total stops. Explore everything from burgers and barbecue to town squares and historic churches.

Great River Road Trail is a scenic journey packed with history. Trail-goers will embark along a path of natural beauty and abundant wildlife, exploring small towns whose stories of the civil war and natural events shaped Tennessee's western border.

Walking Tall Trail brings travelers along a 120-stop route through some of West Tennessee's most charming towns. Enjoy your new favorite meal at a mom-and-pop eatery, bask in the sunshine and fresh air of the region's nature, and discover places that are home to pioneers such as rockabilly icon Carl Perkins, influential blues musician Sleepy John Estes, author Alex Haley, and Sheriff Buford Pusser, after whom the trail is named.

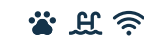

The McKellar-Sipes Regional Airport was established in 1941 by the U.S. Government as a military aviation training center. Today, it serves as a civilian airport for the City of Jackson and Madison County.

The airport has a total area of over 800 acres and boasts a 6,000 foot grooved surface primary runway equipped with a category 1 instrument landing system, as well as a 3,500 foot secondary runway. This makes the airport well-equipped to handle a range of aircraft, from small private planes to commercial airliners.
